VIGIPIRATE

For safety reasons, it is prohibited to bring in, drive, and park any motorized vehicle in all the entrance halls of EUREXPO whether for the set-up or dismantling phases, except for the motorized vehicles presented for the purpose of the exhibition.

If the Exhibitor (or any person authorized by it) does not comply with such prohibition, the Organisation keeps the right to remove or to allow the removing of such vehicle at the expenses and risks of the Exhibitor and without any entitlement to compensation for damages.

HEALTH CONDITIONS : HORSES– DONKEYS – PONIES

A TRACES NT document for horses stationed outside France is required and must be presented upon arrival or a certificate issued by an approved veterinarian, indicating that horses and related equine species have been free of clinical signs from Category 1 infectious diseases for at least 30 days (equine infectious anaemia, West-Nile disease, equine swine fever) for horses stationed in France.

Electronic transponders are mandatory.

Equine flu vaccination is mandatory according to the protocol in force since 1st January 2013: the “vaccination” sheet should include a visa from a veterinary who is not the owner of the animal. Equine viral rhinopneumonitis recommended

DEFINITIONS

General Terms of Sale or GTS: present general terms defining the rights and obligations of the Organizer and the Exhibitors in the framework of the organization and conduct of the Event (marketplace website).

Contract: comprises (i) the Participation request accepted by the Organizer and the related Quotation (if applicable to the Event), (ii) the General Terms of Sale, (iii) the individual Terms of Sale referred to in the previous provisions or regulations for the provision of additional services agreed between the Parties.

Quotation: the commercial offer of provision of services by the Organizer to the Exhibitor for the Event, as described in the Participation request and the Terms of Sale.

Participation request: file returned by the Exhibitor wishing to take part at the Event.

Spaces: spaces made available to the Exhibitor at the venue of the Event as part of the Event, intended to be used by the Exhibitor.

Exhibitor Area: area on the Event's website, containing various particulars reserved for Exhibitors, including the Exhibitor Guide.

Organizer: any natural and/or legal person having concluded the Contract with the Exhibitor for the provision of services related to the Event in question.

Organizer: the organizer of the Event, namely CL events Equestrian Sport, a simplified joint stock company with a capital of 1000000 euros, registered in the Lyon Trade and Companies Register under number 431 100 562, whose registered office is located at 59 Quai Rambaud - 69002 Lyon.

Event: any public event, gathering and campaign organized by the Organizer in France and abroad, such as horse shows, exhibitions, etc. The Event can be conducted on a physical site and/or via a digital platform.

Provision of Services: provision of services, products rented and/or purchased by the Exhibitor from the Organizer, as foreseen in the Quotation, and where applicable, the purchase orders for the provision of further services. The Provisions of Services concern the physical participation in the Event and, as the case may be, the participation in the digital Event (the Event).

PREMIUM: - The Exhibitor and Organizer (hereafter individually or collectively "the Party" or "the Parties") have met to define and establish the terms and conditions of the participation request and the Quotation, and the Organizer hereby states its legal intent. Following their discussions, the Exhibitor and Organizer have agreed to collaborate under the conditions set out below. In that respect, the Contract replaces any other document previously exchanged between the Parties.

Participation request: The Exhibitor and the Organizer hereby state that they have received all the necessary information concerning their commitments and that they have fully understood and agreed to their commitments under the terms of said Contract.

The Exhibitor accordingly acknowledges that its essential obligations under the contract are as follows:

- (i) to provide all the information and/or terms and/or to perform all the steps necessary for the Event (the Event);
 - (ii) to make full payment of the price of the Contract price, within agreed deadlines.
- For its part, the Organizer recognizes that its essential obligation is to provide, on a non-exclusive basis, the services and products related to the Event, and where applicable, the purchase orders for additional services, within the agreed time limit and according to the required quality standards.

The Exhibitor will participate in a digital event related to the Event, the Organizer will communicate to the Exhibitor the specific conditions of participation for this digital event.

ARTICLE 1 - ORDER FOR THE PROVISION OF SERVICES

1) Participation requests are made using special forms, specific to each event, either in paper or electronic form. They are filled in and signed by the Exhibitors themselves. The Exhibitor's participation request is sent to the Organizer by email, by post, by fax, by telephone, by hand, or by any other means, and is signed by the Exhibitor or by any natural person duly empowered for that purpose. The Contract is binding and the Exhibitor is committed to pay the price, either upon receipt of the signed version of it in paper format, or by electronic means, as the case may be, within the time limit specified in section 3 below, subject to any refusal duly justified by the Organizer as set out in section 3 below.

Any Participation request implies the Exhibitor's total acceptance of:

- the Contract;
- the safety specifications - internal regulations of the Event's venue;
- the specific technical regulations specified in the Exhibitor Area (construction regulations, etc.);
- the specific regulations of the Event.

The Contract therefore includes all the aforesaid documents and all public-interest provisions governing Events. The Exhibitor also undertakes to comply with any new Terms of Sale or Quotation published by the Organizer, even if they are different from the interests of the Event so require.

ARTICLE 12 - ORDER FOR THE PROVISION OF SERVICES IN ELECTRONIC FORM

1) The Exhibitor wishes to participate in the Event via a digital platform. The Exhibitor is to its Exhibitor Area with its username and a password to access and fill in the Participation request provided in the interface.

2) The Exhibitor confirms, on the page showing a summary of the Participation request, the deposit payment method and the contents of the Contract. The Exhibitor must acknowledge that it has read and accepts the provisions of the Contract before the Event. Its Participation request is then sent to the Organizer by email, by post, by fax, by telephone, by hand, or by any other means, and is signed by the Exhibitor or by any natural person duly empowered for that purpose, and in so doing the Exhibitor is deemed to have signed and unreservedly accepted the Contract. The Exhibitor will then receive an e-mail confirming that its Participation request has been received by the Organizer. A summary of this request and the Contract in PDF version are available on the Exhibitor Area.

ARTICLE 2 - EXHIBITORS & CO-EXHIBITORS

2) In support of its Participation request, the Exhibitor is required to forward a signed copy of the Terms of Sale or GTS, as the case may be, if it is an importer or manufacturer or agent considered as an intermediary, by each of the firms whose products or equipment will be exhibited. The Organizer reserves the right to check that the type of equipment or product exhibited complies with the provisions of the Terms of Sale or GTS, and, if necessary, request, if any of the above recommendations are not followed, the Organizer will be forced to take corrective measures that may include closing the unacceptable place and/or the Contract.

2) The main Exhibitor can host a co-Exhibitor on its stand, subject to prior validation by the Organizer, when authorized by the Event. In that case, any Exhibitor present on the stand of the main Exhibitor must register its presence with the Organizer, and the Organizer, by completing a Participation request and signing a Contract with the Organizer according to the terms set out herein. The Exhibitor will then be invited for a registration on the Exhibitor Area. The Exhibitor must also provide a copy of the Participation request to the Organizer. In addition, a co-Exhibitor is required to leave its equipment on the site throughout the Event, remove therefrom being strictly prohibited.

During the Event, the Exhibitor must ensure the safety and immediate surroundings. Exhibitors must not act or behave in such a way that could be construed as free-riding or unfair competition with regard to the Event and/or its Exhibitors and/or Partners. The Organizer reserves the right to refuse access or remove temporarily or permanently any Exhibitor whose behavior is deemed unacceptable by the Organizer, and, in this case, the Organizer and/or the other Exhibitors and/or visitors.

ARTICLE 3 - PARTICIPATION REQUESTS, PROCESS OF ADMISSION OR REFUSAL

3) The Organizer may decide at any time, even after receiving the Participation request as set out in article 1 above, to refuse or accept reservations, without recourse. The Organizer may therefore refuse a Participation request, justifying its refusal either on the basis of the provisions of article 2 and/or 12 herein and/or, as the case may be, if the Exhibitor's offer is inconsistent with the strategic positioning of the Event. The stands are deemed to be reserved for the new exhibitors who can take away the benefit from the Event. The Organizer draws up the general plan of the Event with regard to the strategic positioning of the Event, the products or services in question and the places available on the Event. The Organizer reserves the right to refuse access or remove temporarily or permanently any Exhibitor whose behavior is deemed unacceptable by the Organizer, and, in this case, the Organizer and/or the other Exhibitors and/or visitors.

3) The Organizer reserves the right to refuse access or remove temporarily or permanently any Exhibitor whose behavior is deemed unacceptable by the Organizer, and, in this case, the Organizer and/or the other Exhibitors and/or visitors.

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3.2.1 - Selection process of exhibitors - Surface of the Place

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The application must be sent to the Organizer in writing, completed, signed and accompanied by the Exhibitor's Participation request and the Terms of Sale or GTS, as the case may be. The Organizer reserves the right to refuse access or remove temporarily or permanently any Exhibitor whose behavior is deemed unacceptable by the Organizer, and, in this case, the Organizer and/or the other Exhibitors and/or visitors.

3.2.2 - Selection criteria

The selection of candidates is made by the Organizer, within the limits of available places, and is based on the following criteria:

- consistency of the application with the general strategy of the Event, the balance of the offer for each specialty and each market segment, the targeted developments and the commercial strategy;
- presentation of products or collections representing a positive contribution to the general offer of the Event;
- selection of products of new original collections or new products developed and marketed directly by the candidate;
- reputation of the candidate, commercial reputation, ability to respond effectively to international demand;
- the candidate's commitment to rigorously respect the laws and principles protecting industrial property, social rights and the environment most commonly accepted by the international community;
- medium-term financial strength and short-term solvency;
- transparency of the information provided.

3.2.3 - Admission

The decision to admit or refuse admission does not have to be justified, as the Organizer freely selects the candidates, after examination of the files and according to the selection criteria.

3.2.4 - Refusal

The decision to refuse is therefore not subject to appeal. The rejection of an application for participation may not under any circumstances give rise to damages. The decision of admission or refusal of admission has effect only for the Event and the decision which is not subject to appeal.

3.2.5 - Surface of the Place

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The Exhibitor shall state in the application form the surface of the Place desired. The Exhibitor will be allocated a surface area, which will be determined by the Organizer, taking into account the following criteria:

- the event, that the surface area allocated by the Organizer is less than or more than 100 m²; in the latter case, the Exhibitor must provide a justification to the Organizer, who remains free to grant or refuse the Exhibitor's request;
